Dress Code strictly enforced.

Guidelines

- Only students from invited schools with properly completed permission slips and ID are welcome. NO guests from non-invited schools will be permitted. Parent contact number must be legible.
- Students will remain in the building during the dance and UNTIL parents come INTO THE SCHOOL to pick them up. No students may wait outside for their rides or walk home.
- Alcohol, tobacco and drugs, in possession or consumed, will be cause for removal from the dance and /or referral to the police.
- RESPECT for school property, chaperones, DJ, and other persons in attendance is expected and required. No obscene language, clothing or dancing will be allowed. Students are not allowed to dance on the stage.
- Cell phones, coats, purses, backpacks, sports bags and hats must be checked in at the entrance and will be returned at the end of the dance. If caught using a phone, it will be confiscated until after the dance and released to the student's adult at pick-up.

Dress Code

Dress code: All attendees are expected to dress appropriately. Dress code for the school dance must be Catholic-school appropriate. No jeans or pants with large holes or graffiti, no sagging. No halter tops, spaghetti straps, visible undergarments or any tops that do not cover the waist. Skirts and shorts cannot be shorter than your fingertips with your arms hanging at your sides. Students with inappropriate attire will not be allowed to enter and their parents will be called to pick them up.

Permission Slip

I understand that this event will take place on parish grounds, and that adult chaperones will be present throughout the dance. My child agrees to abide by all the guidelines set forth by St. George Parish School. As parent or legal guardian, I am legally responsible for that which may result from any personal actions taken by my child while participating in this event. I agree to release and hold harmless St. George Parish School, the Archdiocese of Seattle and their agent and employees from financial responsibility incurred as a result of my child's participation. In the event of an emergency, where medical treatment is required, I give permission to an adult leader to obtain services of an EMT, physician or hospital staff. I will be notified as soon as possible in such an emergency.

I/my designated chaperone will walk into the building to pick up my student no later than 8:30 p.m.
